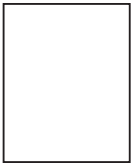

East on Rte. 10 to Rte. 212SE, to Rte. 27 South to Sugarloaf.

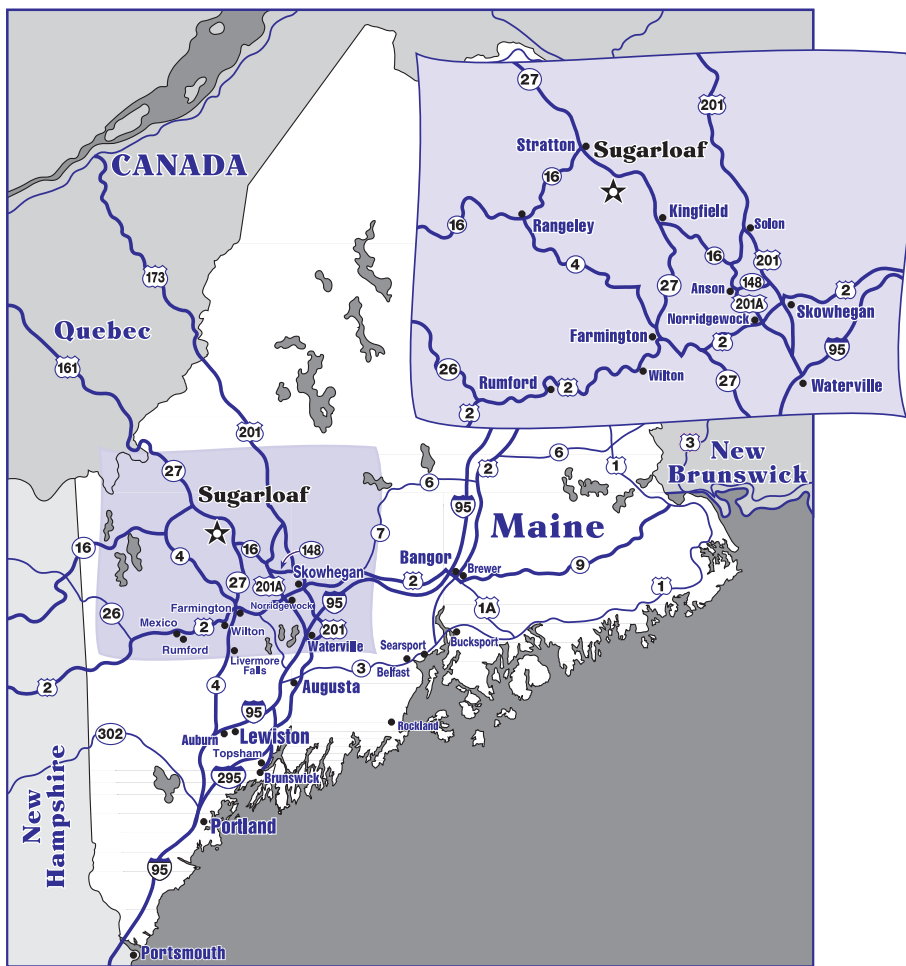
From Vermont & points Southwest:
